## DumpsterGard, LLC Two Year Limited Warranty

Effective March 24<sup>th</sup>, 2026

DumpsterGard (“Company”) warrants that its DumpsterGard lid system panels (“Panels”) will be free from material defects in workmanship and materials under normal use for a period of **two (2) years from the date of delivery** (“Warranty Period”).

This warranty is pro-rated as described below.

This Limited Warranty applies only to the Panels.

Ratchet straps, buckles, and all tie-down components are excluded from warranty coverage.

### 1. Pro-Rated Warranty Coverage

If a Panel is found to have a defect covered under this Limited Warranty, the purchaser will receive a replacement credit based on the time that has elapsed since delivery:

- **0–6 Months:** 100% replacement credit
- **7–12 Months:** 75% replacement credit
- **13–18 Months:** 50% replacement credit
- **19–24 Months:** 25% replacement credit

The purchaser is responsible for all **shipping, freight, handling**, and any costs exceeding the pro-rated credit amount.

### 2. What This Warranty Covers

- Manufacturing defects in the Panels
- Material failure of the Panels under normal intended use
- Abnormal cracking, splitting, or structural failure not caused by misuse or external force

Panels are designed for use in real-world job site conditions, including exposure to rain, snow, and typical environmental conditions when properly installed.

### 3. What This Warranty Does NOT Cover

- Ratchet straps, buckles, hooks, tie-downs, or winch components
- Improper installation or modification
- Misuse, abuse, neglect, or impact damage

- Damage caused by **extreme weather events** (such as severe storms or abnormal wind conditions beyond normal use)
- Chemical exposure, fire, or hazardous materials
- Normal wear and tear or cosmetic imperfections
- Any damage caused by third-party components or alterations

## 4. Purchaser Responsibilities

To submit a valid claim, purchaser must:

1. Notify Company in writing within 30 days of discovering the defect
2. Provide proof of purchase and delivery date
3. Provide photos or video clearly showing the defect
4. Stop using the defective Panel
5. Dispose of defective Panels at purchaser's cost after credit or replacement is issued (Company does not handle disposal or return shipping)

## 5. Exclusive Remedy

For approved claims, Company will apply the appropriate pro-rated credit toward a replacement Panel.

This is the **sole and exclusive remedy** under this Limited Warranty.

## 6. Disclaimer of Other Warranties

All implied warranties—including merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose—are disclaimed to the fullest extent permitted by law.

## 7. Limitation of Liability

Company shall not be liable for:

- Incidental or consequential damages
- Loss of revenue, business, or use
- Labor, installation, or removal costs

Liability is limited to the value of the pro-rated credit.

## 8. Non-Transferability

This Warranty applies only to the original purchaser and is not transferable.

## 9. Governing Law

This Warranty is governed by applicable state law and is subject to the dispute-resolution terms in Company's posted Terms & Conditions.
